

Information for Colorado Prescribers of Prescription Drugs

OCALIVA® (obeticholic acid)

Intercept Pharmaceuticals, Inc. provides the following information to Colorado prescribers pursuant to Colorado House Bill 19-1131.

The pricing information below reflects the Wholesale Acquisition Costs (“WAC”) for each product. The WAC represents published catalogue or list price and may not represent the actual cost to a patient. How much a patient will pay will depend on the patient’s insurance coverage. To find out the exact cost of a prescription, patients should contact their health insurance company or preferred pharmacy.

Colorado law also requires manufacturers to provide the names of generic prescription drugs from the same “therapeutic class” as the marketed products. Colorado defines “therapeutic class” as “a group of similar drugs that have the same or similar mechanisms of action and are used to treat a specific condition.” There are no generic prescription drugs in the same “therapeutic class” as the products above (based on the definition of “therapeutic class” under Colorado law).
